Fourth Achievement

Since, the National Assembly has three major responsibilities, (1) representing the people, (2) drafting and enacting the laws, (3) and oversight on the executive branch, so the members of the National Assembly, for presenting the view of people, suggestions and complains organize meetings with the senior officials of the government to reach the voices of people to the government.

In order to fill the gap in the zone of sharing information and delivering the recommendation of the members of the National Assembly to the government officials, the office of the State Ministry for Parliamentary Affairs, in 1398, Fiscal year, held (4631) meetings with the Ministers, Deputy Ministers and senior officials of the ministries and government institutions. It is considered a big achievement for the SMPA to become a bridge between the two branches of the government and strengthen their relationship.
